This year marks the organisation's 30th year of service to children and families.


We have been supporting families to improve their quality of life.

Finances



Sickle Cell and Thalassemia Support

Across Wolverhampton and Walsall, a total of 628 individuals received counselling via the Antenatal and Neonatal screening programmes.

During the period of April 2020 to March 2021, we received and processed 391 unusual blood results (these are individuals that have been tested and identified as potentially being affected or a carrier of a haemoglobinopathy) for us to consider action.
