Family Support by SCTSP delivers the Community Family Support Service to families across South Staffordshire and Stafford.

Our aim is to ensure families receive the right support, at the right time, in the right place - whether in the family home, school, or a Family Hub.

What we offer: Tier 2 Family Support

- One-to-one, hands-on practical support
- A named Family Support Worker to coordinate help across schools and other services
- Completion of an Early Help Assessment (EHA) and creation of an Early Help Plan (EHP)
- Close working with professionals and agencies to achieve positive outcomes
